67th Annual Meeting Southern Region of the American Society for Horticultural Sciences Mobile, AL February 3-5, 2007

As usual the meeting will be in conjunction with the Southern Association of Agricultural Scientist (SAAS).

Registration and Pre-Registration Information

This year we will accept Pre-Registration prior to the meeting and Registration at the meeting.

Pre-Registration

Option 1: Pre-Register by Mail and Pay by Check

Deadline: January 19, 2007

Fill-out the Pre-Registration Form at the end of the Newsletter or download the Pre-Registration from the Southern Region web site (srashs.org, forms link). Mail the completed

Pre-Registration Form and check (personal, institutional, organization, foundation) to the Secretary-Treasurer.

Option 2: Pre-Register Online and Pay by Credit Card

Deadline: January 19, 2007

Go to the ASHS web site and enter the ASHS Online Store (ashs.org/shop/home.php). In the categories menu select the link: Southern Region ASHS Annual Meeting Registration. Select "Buy Now" for your registration category. You can register more than one person at once, for example if you want to register a group of ACB club members, graduate students, etc. You also can select "Buy Now" to pay your 2006 and/or 2007 SRASHS dues. Proceed to Checkout and enter the requested personal and credit card information. You will receive a The Southern Region receipt via email. Secretary-Treasurer also will receive a record of those that pre-register. The ASHS Online Store is a secure site.

Pre-Registration prior to the meeting and Registration at the meeting is the same rate. Therefore, Pre-Registration is offered as a convenience. If you do not attend the meeting, for what ever reason, your Pre-Registration will be reimbursed in-full. There will be no penalty for cancellation. If you Pre-Register by check, your refund will be issued after the deadline. If you Pre-Register online through the ASHS Online Store, your refund will be credited to your account.

The Southern Region would like to express its most sincere appreciation to Mike Neff, Executive Director of ASHS, for arranging online Pre-Registration through the ASHS Online Store. Headquarters is offering this as a service, and the only charge will be a small administrative fee charged by the credit card company. This minimal administrative cost will be covered by the Southern Region. Online Pre-Registration is strongly encouraged since the Southern Region does not have a functional staff, except for the Secretary-Treasurer (but he ain't that "functional"!).
